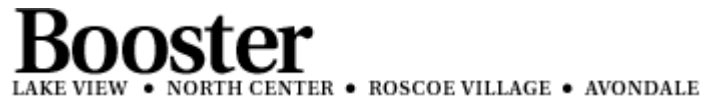

## **Re-elect Cullerton**

Voters in the 6<sup>th</sup> Senate District should keep John Cullerton – who earns our endorsement – around as long as the veteran senator agrees to seek the office.

In his 14 years in the Senate, the full-time lawyer who is Democratic Co-Chair of the Senate's Judiciary Committee, has spearheaded legislation such as the state's mandatory safety belt act and the Child Passenger Safety Act, and continues to be vigilant of traffic safety. Mass transit is also a target issue for Cullerton who wants to see the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) completely restructured, and is pushing Metra to add more stops in Lake View.

The Ravenswood resident co-sponsored the 7 percent property tax cap bill, but also supports a 'tax swap' –increasing income taxes and abating property taxes to pay for schools.

For his 2006 voting record, Cullerton (along with State Rep. Julie Hamos earned the 2004 Ethel Parker award from the Independent Voters of Illinois (IVI/IPO), a non-partisan progressive organization.
